INTRODUCTION

Being established in 1990, with 100% Hungarian private ownership, the core activity of the BIOFILTER Environment Co. comprises the collecting and recycling of exhausted frying oils and frying fats.

Biofilter has 100 employees, and had 350% growth in collecting frying oils, frying fats, culinary-garbage and broken meats from 1996 to 2004.

Biofilter has 4 plants in Hungary and has a logistic centre in Thessaloniki, Greece established in 1998.

Back in 2002, following the introduction of new regulations relating to the culinary-garbage and broken meats arising in the course of culinary activities, as a response to the increasing demand, we obtained the necessary operating licenses for transportation and collection of those culinary-garbage and broken meats. In Budapest as of 1 May 2003, in the country in September 2003 we started out with the collecting and removal of culinary garbage arising from gastronomic activities from our contractual partners.

MAIN ACTIVITIES, PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

Biofilter is planning to expand operations in Croatia and Romania with the aim to increase the activity in the target area in order to set up collection system in the region.

The total collection of the used frying oils was 8.000,-tons in 2006, 5.500 tons of used frying oils was collected in Hungary and the rest from the Greek collection network. The company covering about 40% of the local used cooking oil market in Northern part of Greece.

The revenues from Hungarian operation came from sales of processed used frying oil to biodiesel producers in Austria, Slovakia, the Czech Republic and Romania. The cleaned frying oil product represents unique quality for bio-diesel production.

Biofilter operates a system for the collection of expired food also, which is processed in bio-gas plant. The company has long term and exclusive cooperation with the Budapest Sewage Works (FCSM) for the handling of expired foods in biogas plant.



Biofilter is going to establish a logistic network in China in cooperation with Budapest Sewage Works, in order to operate the existing working model there.
